President's Report:

I don't have very much for a report this month as most of it is covered elsewhere in the newsletter. Last month's speaker went down a treat and we had an awesome turnout. Just a reminder, this month's earlier start time of 6:30pm for the Pot Luck Dinner. Everyone is welcome.

July's Club Night:

This month's Club night is our annual pot luck dinner. Please note the earlier start time. Only four people put their names down on the list and three have called since to advise what they were bringing. Remember we do not need to know exactly what you are bringing, just the course (starter, main or dessert). So far we have

Subscriptions:

Subscriptions are due from 01 August 2012. You will find subscription forms enclosed with this newsletter. Subscription prices are the same as last year – Partnership or Family \$20; Single \$15; Junior \$5; Federation Year Book (comes out January of the following year) \$10 or \$15 if you want it posted. Please remember to fill out your subscription form when you submit your payment as this is used to keep track of who our members are. You still need to fill out a form if you pay by internet banking – just hand it in on a club night.

Bird Database:

This has been a subject raised a few times over the past year or so and it has been decided to move it forward. This is a database of all club members and what bird types they each have. It will be maintained by one member and that member is the only person who will see the list. The current database manager will be our secretary, Helen Kake. She will be contacting everyone over the next month or so to get all your bird lists (if she hasn't got to you already ⁽³⁾). If you do not want to have your birds on the database that is fine - just let her know when she calls you and she will annotate such. The club gets many queries about birds, whether someone is interested in buying or selling or just general information regarding a particular bird breed. Should a query come in, the database can be consulted and the database manager can then contact the member in question. At this point it is up to the member whether they contact the person querying or not – this is not compulsory. Also, the only person contacting the member will be the database manager – no one else, including other club members, will get contact details. All information remains confidential.

Remember: no order form – no order! For those who have not been to the container before, go through the white gates at the end of Tahi Road and follow the road around to the far back of the buildings and around to the right of the buildings and onto the grass.
