November's Seed Order Problems

Those members who ordered seed in November will have an extra letter enclosed with this month's newsletter explaining the problems we had with the order. Please ensure you read it.

March Seed Order

The next seed order is due in March, but the pickup date now clashes with our Exhibition. We propose to still take the order on March's club night but will delay the actual ordering one week so it arrives the weekend after the Exhibition. The last thing we need is to have to scramble around 1+ tons of seed while trying to get all of the Exhibition stocks in and out of the container.

March Exhibition

Yes you are reading it right – this year's Exhibition will be in March instead of the usual April timeframe. The reason – we are having our Exhibition on the same weekend as the Sustainable Home and Garden Show – Saturday 21 March 2015. I can already hear the "are you mad?" comments from some people, but there is a reason behind our madness.

Should a query come in, the database can be consulted and the database manager can then contact the member in question. At this point it is up to the member whether they contact the person querying or not – this is not compulsory. Also, the only person contacting the member will be the database manager – no one else, including other club members, will get contact details. All information remains confidential.

Community Centre Storage
